

H.R. 6810, *Health Care Protection Act* Rep. Rodney Davis, IL-13

Provides six months of premium assistance so workers who have been laid off will not lose or pay more for their health insurance through COBRA. Also creates a 30-day special enrollment period on ACA exchanges for individuals eligible for coverage.

H.R. 8114, Emergency Support for Nursing Homes and Elder Justice Reform Act

Rep. Ann Wagner, MO-02

Protects older Americans from abuse, neglect, and illness; helps nursing homes facing outbreaks; and expands televisitation so elderly Americans can communicate safely with their families, among other programs in partnership with AARP and Elder Justice Coalition.

H.R. 7710, *Open Schools Responsibly Act* Rep. Greg Murphy, NC-03

Provides protections for elementary, secondary, and higher education schools and universities to help them educate America's students during COVID-19 emergency.

H.R. 621, *Student Empowerment Act* Rep. Jason Smith, MO-08

Expands 529 Savings Plans so parents can spend tax-free on expenses related to home learning, public, private, and religious schools to help families navigate the 2020-2021 school year.

H.R. 7248, STARTER Act

Rep. Sam Graves, MO-06

Modernizes America's roads, bridges, transit, and other infrastructure.

H.R. 7804, Back to Work Child Care Grants

Rep. Tom Reed, NY-23

Provides funding to child care providers across the country to stabilize the industry and ensure child care facilities can open and welcome children safely.

H.R. 7992, *Telehealth Act* Rep. Ann Wagner, MO-02

Permanently expands access to telehealth services so people can communicate with their doctors without leaving the safety of their homes. making telehealth more affordable for those on high-deductible health plans, expanding telehealth for veterans, addressing restrictions that deter doctors from providing telehealth services, waiving originating site and geographical restrictions for Medicare, among other improvements.

H.R. 7149, *FSA Flexibility Act* Rep. Gary Palmer, AL-06

Protects families who have been unable to use their 2020 FSA funds due to stay-at-home orders, allowing them to rollover balances, withdraw without penalty, change election amounts, and continue using funds if they lose their jobs.

H.R. 1434, Education Freedom Scholarships and Opportunity Act

Rep. Bradley Byrne, AL-01

Gives tax deductions for private school scholarship donations, helping all families more affordably access their desired schools.

H.R. 5292, Fly Together Act Rep. Ann Wagner, MO-02

Requires airlines to seat young children with an older relative on flights to help families travel safely.
