
MO-02 Congressional Art Competition

- The Competition is open to high school students only- one entry per student.
- Artwork must be two-dimensional, but may include any of the following medias:
 - > Paintings: oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.
 - Drawings: pastels, colored pencils, pencil, charcoal, ink, markers, etc.
 - > Prints: lithographs, silkscreen, block prints
 - Mixed Media
 - Computer Generated Art
 - Photography



- Framing is optional for the district competition. However, the 1st and 2nd place pieces MUST be framed before shipping to Washington, D.C. and must be no larger than 26 inches x 26 inches x 4 inches deep (including the frame). The 3rd place piece must also be framed before hanging in Congresswoman Wagner's district office.
- Each entry must be original in concept, design, and execution and may not violate any U.S. copyright laws. Any entry that has been copied from an existing photo (other than the student's own), painting, graphic, advertisement, or any other work produced by another person is a violation of the competition's rules and will not be accepted.
- Artwork must adhere to the policy of the House Office Building Commission, therefore pieces depicting subjects of contemporary political controversy, or a sensationalistic or gruesome nature are not allowed.
